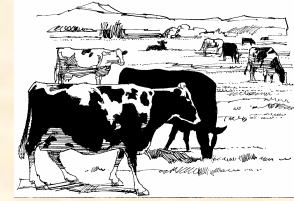


Pasture Tracker

Use a hand held PDA computer along with the GPS unit to chart daily allotment area.
Chart and Map paddocks acreage.

Adjust area consumed and be able to accurately measure that area.
